DISPLAY BOOTH

- We will provide two long tables for each item.
- You should have a vertical, freestanding display (poster board) of your product and work done by your team. It should be as self-explanatory as possible. It should prominently display the name of your team and product.
- Your final business plan should be available for viewing and reading.
- You should present your pamphlet, newspaper ad, radio spot, or TV commercial.

Note: Start now to locate extension cords, a TV, a computer, a monitor, a VCR, or whatever other equipment you will need on May 23. Dr. Filer or Mr. Fisher will help teams locate equipment if you give them a minimum of one week to do so.

- Two or three students at a time will be representatives at the booth. Representatives will rotate every half hour, from 9 A.M. to 11:35 A.M. (with five time slots). All team members should be knowledgeable about all aspects of your project, because the judges will be visiting and asking questions all morning.
