- 3. CHOOSE ONE OF THE UNDERLINED OR HIGHLIGHTED TYPES OF FIGURATIVE LANGUAGE. EXPLAIN IT AND SHOW HOW IT IS CONNECTED TO THE POET'S OVERALL MESSAGE IN THE POEM {ANALYTICAL OR DEEPER MEANING}.
- 4. HOW DOES THE WEATHER AFFECT THE POET? USE EVIDENCE FROM THE TEXT TO EXPLAIN YOUR ANSWER.
