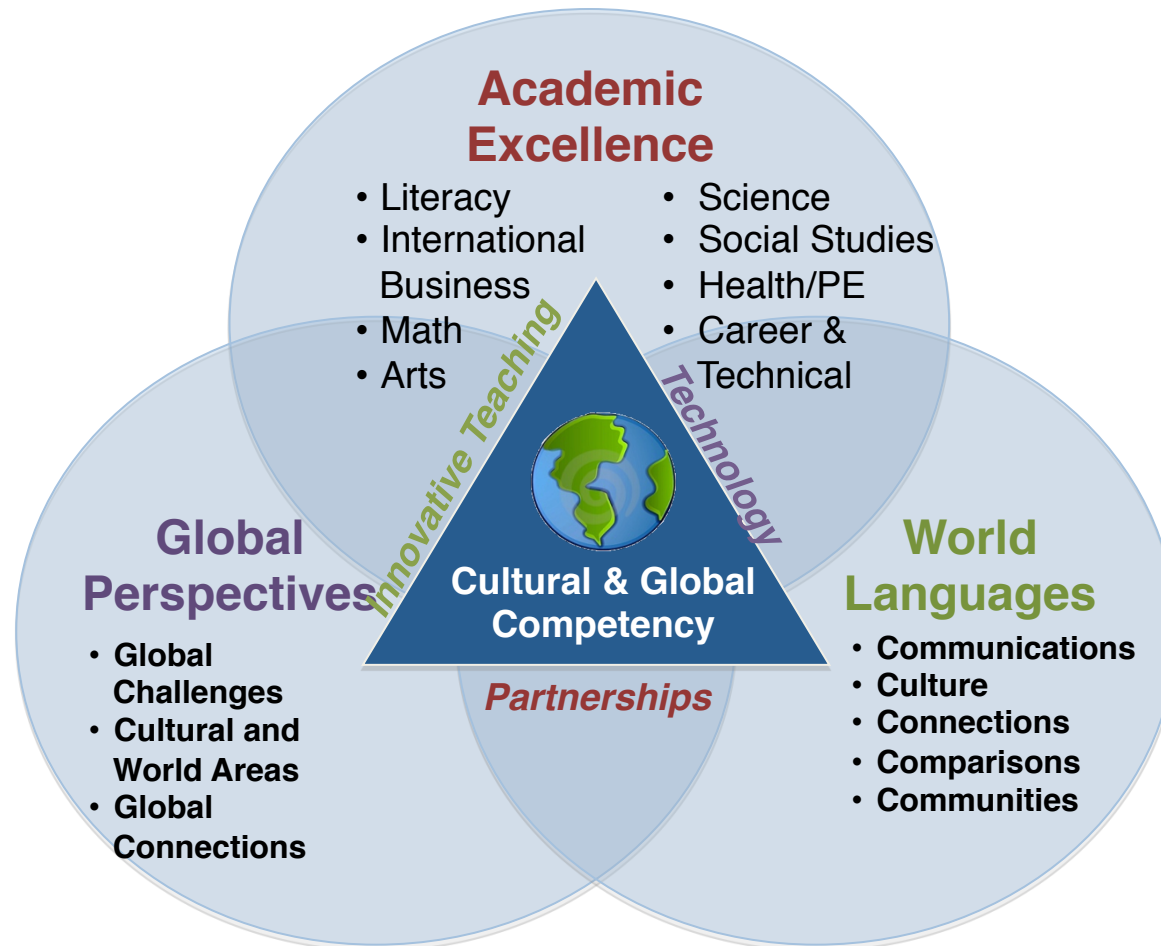

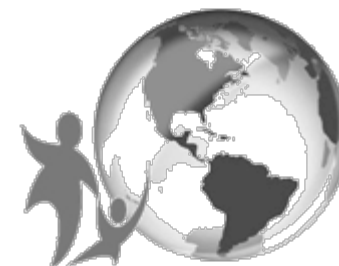

The Seven Components of International Education

1. **Academic Excellence** – Students meeting or exceeding state and federal standards in all academic areas
2. **Global Perspective** – All content areas have a global/multiple perspective analysis embedded in the learning
3. **World Languages** – Students learn world languages through dual immersion and world language classes
4. **Technology** – Students access technology in order to communicate, research and build relationships with others locally and globally



The Seven Components of International Education

- 5. Partnerships** – Schools develop authentic partnerships with all stakeholders
- 6. Innovative Teaching** – Teachers employ best practices in instruction and assessment
- 7. Cultural Competency** – Students gain understanding of other cultures, value the contributions of all people, understand own racial and cultural identity, and take action to address the world's most pressing social injustices
