 - a. You may title and change the text on this page. The purpose of this page will be to post the various pictures we capture or create. This might be something you mention in this section.
 - b. This will automatically add all of the pictures to their own page.
- 5.) On this picture page, you will need to give each picture a caption. Most likely you will use the one from the Scavenger Hunt. You will also need to title the page and write a short explanation of what the user will see on this page.
