### Rules

- Only write in the books you have recently read or taught. Recent = in the last year
- You may only use a title in one cell. For example, while Malala Yousafzai's *We Are Displaced* would fit in several categories. If you have recently read or taught this book, you may only use it once.
- Color code:
  - Black ink = books you've read recently
  - Red ink = book recommendations from peers
  - For teachers: Blue ink = books you've taught recently
